Christenson of Newburg, Oregon, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, assign, sell and set over, and by these presents do sell, assign and set over unto said N. C. Christenson the following personal property to-wit: now located in Skamania County, State of Washington:

All buildings, including saw mill, donkey engines, mill equipment, cables, blocks, saws, falling axes tools, machinery, and all other articles of personal property, belonging to the said J. C. Elrod, and which was procured by him from the Iowa Lumber Co., and also being upon the following described properties, to-wit:-

The Isaac N. Bush Donation Land Claims, Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Nine (9) in Section Ten (10), Lot Six (6) of Section Fourteen (14), Lots Two (2) and Seven (7) of Section Fifteen (15), in Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) East of Willamette Meridian, and all being in Skamania County, Washington.
