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A. CLASSIFICATION UNDER CHAPTER 94.34 RCW. I/we request that this land retain the current use classification as [] Open Space Land, [] Farm and Agricultural Land, [] Timberland, and I am/we are aware of the following use classification of the land:

OPEN SPACE LAND MEANS EITHER:

- any land area so designated by an official comprehensive land use plan adopted by any city or county and soned accordingly; or
- b) any land area, the preservation of which in its present use would: (i) conserve and enhance natural or scenic resources; (ii) protect streams or water supply; (iii) protect conservation of soils, wetlands, beaches, or tidal marshes; (iv) enhance the value to the public of abutting or neighboring parks, forests, wildlife preserves, nature reservations or sanctuaries or other open space; (v) enhance recreation opportunities; (vi) preserve historic sites; (vii) preserve visual quality along highway, road, and street corridors or scenic vistas; or (viii) retain in its natural state tracts of had not less than one acre situated in an urban area and open to public use on such conditions as may be reasonably required by the legislative body greating the open space classification; or
- c) any land that meets the definition of farm and agricultural conservation land. "Farm and agricultural conservation land is either: (i) land that was previously classified as open space farm and agricultural land that no longer meets the criteria of farm and agricultural land, and that is reclassified as open space and under RCW 84.34.020(1); or (ii) land that is traditional farmland that is not classified under chapter 84.33 or 84.34 RCW, that has not been irrevocably devoted to a use inconsistent will, agricultural uses, and that has a high potential for returning to commercial agriculture.

2. FARM AND AGRICULTURAL LAND MEANS EITHER:

- any land in contiguous ownership of twenty or more seres devoted: (i) primarily to the production
 of livestock or agricultural commodities, for commercial purposes; or (ii) enrolled in the federal
 conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of
 agriculture; or (iii) other similar commercial activities as may be established by rule; or
- b) any parcel of land at least five a cres but less than twenty acres devoted primarily to agricultural uses and produces a gross income equal to two hundred dollars or more per acre per year for three out of the five calendar years preceding the date of application for classification under chapter 34.34 RCW; or
- c) any parcel of land that is less than five acres devoted primarily to agricultural uses and produces a gross income equal to fifteen hundred dollars or more per year for three out of the five calendar years preceding the date of application for classification under chapter 84.34 RCW; or
- d) any land on which the principal place of residence of the farm operator or owner of land or housing for employees is sited if the classified farm and agricultural land is classified pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, if the residence or housing is on or contiguous to the classified parcel, and the use of the residence or housing is integral to the use of the classified land for agricultural purposes.

Agricultural land also includes (i) land on which appurtenances necessary for the production, preparation, or sale of commercial agricultural products are situated when the appurtenances are used in conjunction with the land(s) producing agricultural products, (ii) land incidentally used for an activity or enterprise that is compatible with commercial agricultural purposes as long as the incidental use does not exceed twenty percent of the classified land, and (iii) any noncontiguous parcel of land from one to five acres in size that constitutes an integral part of the commercial agricultural operations of a classified parcel of farm and agricultural land.

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TIMBER LAND MEANS any land in contiguous ownership of five or more acres devoted primarily
to the growing and harvesting of forest crops for commercial purposes and not classified as
reforestation land pursuant to Chapter 84.28 RCW. Timber land means the land only.

L'we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of withdrawal or removal of this land from classification to the following extent:

- If the owner has filed the proper notice of request to withdraw the classified land and the land has been classified for a minimum of ten years he/she shall pay an amount equal to the difference between the tax computed on the basis of "current use" and the tax computed on the basis of true and fair value plus interest at the same statutory rate charged on delinquent property taxes. The additional tax and interest shall be paid for the preceding seven years.
- 2. If land is removed from classification because of a change to a non-conforming use, land is removed prior to the minimum ten year period, or land is removed because the owner(s) failed to comply with the two year notice of withdrawal he/she shall be liable to pay the additional tax and interest described in 1 above plus a penalty of twenty percent of the additional tax and interest.  - a natural disaster such as a flood, windstorm, earthquake, or other calamity rather than by virtue

 - d) official action by an agency of the state of Washington or by the county or city within which the sand is located that disallows the present classified use of the land;
 - e) transfer of land to a church when the land would qualify for exemption pursuant to RCW \$4.36.020;
 - acquisition of property interests by a state or federal agency, county, city, town, metropolitan
 park district; metropolitan municipal corporation, nonprofit historic preservation corporation as

- a) CLASSIFIED FOREST LAND is land whose highest and best use is the growing and harvesting of timber.
- b) DESIGNATED FOREST LAND is land that is primarily devoted to and used for growing and harvesting timber but whose value for other purposes may be greater than its value for use as forest land.

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I/we declare that I am/we are aware of the liability of removal of this land from classification or designation and upon removal a compassating tax shall be imposed that shall be equal to the difference between the amount of tax last levied on the land as forest land and an amount equal to the new assessed valuation of the land multiplied by the millage rate of the last levy extended against the land, multiplied by land, not greater than ten, equal to the number of years the land was classified or designated as forest land.
