Wallace, being first duly sworn, depose and say; that I am the grantor in that certain Flowage Easement under date December 14, 1937, wherein I granted to the United States a perpetual flowage easement over 7.03 acres of mmy land situate in Lot 3, Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 9 East lying southerly of the south line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's right of way, and in Lots 1 and 2, Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, and more particularly described in said flowage easement under date of December 14, 1937.
