KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That E. C. Hamilton and Maggie E. Hamilton, husband and wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to them in hand paid, do hereby CONVEY and WARRANT unto Paul C. Miller and May Miller, husband and wife, parties of the second part, the following described real property in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a post marking the intersection of the west line of the Shepard Donation Land Claim with the Northerly line of Second Street of the Town of Stevenson; thence North 55°30' East along Second Street a distance of 56.5 feet to an iron pipe one-half inch in diameter set in the ground which bears South 55°30' West a distance of 3 feet from the southwesterly corner of frame building; thence North 34°30' West a distance of 44 feet to an iron pipe one-half inch in diameter set in the ground which bears North 70° 30' West a distance of 5 feet from the Northwesterly corner of the above mentioned frame building; thence North 55°30' East a distance of 25.5 feet to an iron pipe one-half inch in diameter set in the ground; thence North 18°30' West a distance of 66 feet to an iron pipe one-half inch in diameter set in the ground; thence in a Westerly direction a distance of 22 feet to intersection with the West line of the Shepard Donation Land Claim at a point which is North 137.5 feet from the point of beginning; thence South to the place of beginning.

Excepting and reserving however, septic tank, situate near the westerly line of above described premises together with an easement for sewer pipe connection therewith to the frame building above mentioned and the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of repairing the same.
