Phillips is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the Government and its assigns, forever, the full and perpetual right, power, privilege and easement to overflow, as hereinbefore stated, to the extent of the right, title and interest of the Grantors therein, all that portion of the following described lands and all those portions of any and all improvements, buildings and/or structures, whether the same be fixtures or movables, resting or located upon said lands lying below the 83.0-foot contour line above mean see level, as determined by reference to the U. S. C. & G. S. datum, situate in Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamamia County, Washington, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
