Frank A. Wachter, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and say: I am familiar
with the location of the water main belonging to the Water Department of the Town of
Stevenson extending over the property described in Flowage Easement to United States of
America over land belonging to Lloyd T. Harshman, Skamania County, Hugh B. Smith et ux
and Floyd McKelvey as the same was located and in existence prior to the flooding of
said lands by the backwater from the Bonneville Dam and also subsequent to its location
by reason of said backwater.

The said water main has existed across said properties without any substantial
change in location during a period of more than twenty years prior to 1937. The only
change made during said period was a re-location over the property belonging to Floyd
McKelvey about 1929 or 1930. During all this time the Town of Stevenson and its predece-
ssor in interest has held the peaceful possession of said water main and the easements
upon which it is located under claim of right and title thereto; said possession has been
open and notorious and has not been questioned by any person whomsoever.
