RE: Flowage Easement granted by Hauser Construction Company, an Oregon corporation to the United States of America, under date of December 20, 1938, over a portion of Lot 3, Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington.

I, Glen W. Shoemaker, being first duly sworn, depose and say:

That I am Associate Land Appraiser, U. S. Engineer Office, Portland, Oregon, and that I am familiar with the property over which the above named Hauser Construction Company, an Oregon corporation, granted a flowage easement to the United States of America, as above described, and that I have examined said property on the ground.

I further depose and say that that certain right of way or easement granted the Northwestern Electric Company for the right to construct and perpetually maintain and operate two pole or power lines for the transmission of electric current over a part of said Government Lot 3, as shown by Book "O" of Deed records of Skamania County, Washington, at page 264, will not interfere with the use of the above granted property to the United States Government for the reason that said power lines are located upon high ground other than that covered by said flowage easement and are not within the area affected by flowage and included in said flowage easement.

I further depose and say that the power line formerly constructed and maintained over and across said premises by virtue of that certain easement or right of way deed recorded in Book "Z" of Deed Records of Skamania County, Washington, at page 541, has been removed from the premises affected by flowage and has been relocated and reconstructed upon high ground outside of the flowage area and that settlement with the West Coast Power Company has been made therefor, and the property covered by said flowage easement is not now affected thereby.

I further depose and ^{say} that flowage easement has been acquired by the United States Government from the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company covering its right of way line across said Lot 3, and that therefore the easement and right of way in favor of said Railway Company does not interfere with the contemplated use of said property.
