Fred H. Wilson et ux et al by sheriff to Foster Borchgrevink

This Indenture, made this 19th day of December 1939 between Irene H. Borden sheriff of the County of Skamania State of Washington, party of the first part, and Foster Borchgrevink of the County of Clark State of Washington party of the second part, witnesseth;

That, Whereas, by virtue of a general execution issued out of and under the seal of the Superior Court of the State of Washington, in and for said county, on the 24th day of August, 1938, upon a judgment rendered in said court in cause No. 2581 C on the 22nd: day of August 1938, in favor of Foster Borchgrevink and against Fred Herbert Wilson and Violet Wilson husband and wife, J. E. Ofelt, Marie Addington, First National Bank of Portland, Oregon, a national banking association and Troy Mansfield and to the Sheriff of said County duly directed and delivered, commanding him that of the personal property of the said judgment debtor in his county, he should cause to be made certain moneys in said execution specified, and if sufficient personal property of the said judgment debtor could not be found, he should then cause the amount so specified to be made out of the lands, tenements and real estate of the said judgment debtor, on the 24th day of September, 1938, or at any time afterwards;
