

The land embraced within a proposed right of way for an electric transmission line, consisting of approximately twenty-four and eight hundredths (24.08) acres being a strip of land entirely across the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-six (26) and the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) quarter of Section twenty-seven (27) all in township two (2) North, Range Five (5) East of Willamette Meridian in Skamania County, State of Washington, which strip of land is more particularly described as the property lying Two Hundred Twelve and a Half (212 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet northerly and easterly and Eighty-seven and a Half (87 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet southerly and Westerly, measured at right angles from the survey line. The said survey line being described as follows:
