IN THE MATTER OF Secondary STATE HIGHWAY NO 8-B, Washougal River to McPherson's Store.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Phillip Buslach, also known as Philip C. Buslach and Alyce Buslach his wife, of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Ten and 00/100 Dollars, in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ha_ granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the State of Washington, the following described parcel of land situated in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 100 feet wide (except as may be hereinafter specified), being 50 feet wide on the northeastward side and 50 feet wide on the southwestward side of the center line of said highway as surveyed over and across the SW¹/₄ of Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 5 E.W.M., excepting right of way of existing highway. Grantee shall provide an approach to a private road when constructed by grantors at about Engineering Survey Station 660+00

the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Director of Highways at Olympia, and bearing date of approval August 24th, 1937.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, unto the State of Washington forever.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD and agreed that the delivery of this deed is hereby tendered and such tender kept good until revoked but that the terms and obligations hereof shall not become binding upon the State of Washington unless and until accepted and approved hereon in writing for the State of Washington, Department of Highways, by the Right of Way Engineer.
