Confirmatory Flowage Easement.

This Indenture, made this 26th day of January, 1940, between Helena St. Martin, a single woman, being now of legal age, hereinafter called the Grantor, and The United States of America, hereinafter called the Government, witnesseth:

That Whereas, under date of December 29, 1938, Aurelia Kelly, et al., for the consideration therein expressed, made, executed and delivered to the United States of America or its assigns, a flowage easement over the hereinafter described real property and which said flowage easement was executed on behalf of Grantor by M. W. Beck, the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian for Helena St. Martin, a then minor; and

Whereas, said Helena St. Martin, being now of legal age, and it being desired that said easement shall be ratified and confirmed by said Grantor herein;

Now Therefore, the said Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), cash in hand paid by the Government, and of the premises, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the purpose of ratifying and confirming the easement as aforesaid, does hereby GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and CONVEY to the Government or its assigns, forever, the full and perpetual right, power, privilege and easement to overflow, as hereinbefore stated, all that portion of the following described land lying below the 94-foot contour line
