

pany"), Party of the First Part, the Interstate Construction Corporation, The Bridge of the Gods Corporation and Wauna Toll Bridge Company, each a Washington corporation (therein jointly called the "Construction Corporations"), Party of the Second Part, and The Western Union Telegraph Company, a New York corporation (therein called "Telegraph Company"), Party of the Third Part, as modified and supplemented by that certain supplemental agreement dated February 1, 1940, by and between the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, an Oregon corporation, and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Utah corporation (therein collectively called "Railroad Companies"), Party of the First Part; Wauna Toll Bridge Company, a Washington corporation (therein called "Bridge Company"), Party of the Second Part, and The Western Union Telegraph Company, a New York corporation (therein called "Telegraph Company"), Party of the Third Part.

6. THAT CERTAIN LEASE contained in an agreement dated May 10, 1927, by and between the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, an Oregon corporation, and Wauna Toll Bridge Company, a Washington corporation, as extended by a certain extension rider dated December 7, 1931, an extension rider dated January 28, 1937, an extension rider dated February 10, 1942, an extension rider dated December 23, 1946, and an extension rider dated October 16, 1951.

7. THAT CERTAIN RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND PERMISSION GRANTED by the State of Oregon to occupy a portion of the right of way of the Columbia River Highway in the County of Hood River and State of Oregon between Highway Engineers Station 1896+24 and Highway Engineers Station 1899+45 for and in connection with the construction of the approach to The Bridge of the Gods, all as granted and provided in that certain agreement made and entered into the 3rd day of March, 1939, by and between the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission (therein called "State"), Party of the First Part, and the Wauna Toll Bridge Company, a corporation (therein called "Company"), Party of the Second Part.
