J. A. Klum to Rose Klum

This agreement, made and entered into this First day of February, 1935, by and between J. A. Klum and Rose Klum husband and wife, residing at Stevenson in Skamania County, State of Washington, witnesseth:

That, whereas, said J. A. Klum and Rose Klum are the owners of certain real estate described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 613 feet south of the center of Section 36 in Township 3 North of Range 7 East of Willamette Meridian; running thence south 281 feet; thence west 310 feet; thence north 281 feet; thence east 310 feet to place of beginning, containing two acres more or less. Also:

Beginning at a point 469 feet south of the center of Section 36 Tp. 3 N. R. 7 E.W. M., thence south 140.5 feet; thence west 310 feet; thence north 140.5 feet; thence east 310 feet to the place of beginning.

All in Skamania County, State of Washington, the same being now held in the name of said J. A. Klum and Rose Klum and being desirous that said property and any other real estate that may be hereafter acquired in the name of said J. A. Klum and Rose Klum shall pass without delay or expense in case of the death of either of said parties to the survivor:

A. Klum survives, the whole of said property hereinbefore described, together with any other property by them hereafter acquired, shall at once vest in the said J. A. Klum in fee simple.
