Witnesseth; That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars Dollars lawful money of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, CONVEY and CONFIRM unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

All of the No of the NE of the NW tof the NE t, Section 36, Township 4 N, Range 72 E Willamette Meridian, containing 5 acres, more or less, excepting one acre, more fully described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the Pat Freeman tract, thence East, one hundred and seventy (170) feet on the North Line of said tract, which point is the place of beginning; thence East along the north line of the Pat Feeeman Tract one hundred and thirty two (132) feet; thence South at right angle to North line three hundred and thirty (330) feet; thence West at right angle one hundred and thirty two (132) feet; thence North at right angles three hundred and thirty (330) feet; to place of beginning, containing one acre more or less and having been previously deeded to Clifford Munger and Helen Munger, his wife and Charles Pride and Jane Pride, his wife as recorded in Book Y, records of Skamania County, Washington on page 224, dated June 13, 1935.
