For and in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00), in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, Henry Muessig, a widower now and at the time of acquiring title, have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the United States of America and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way over, upon, under, and across the following-described land in the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington; to-wit:

That portion of the Northeast quarter (NEt) of the Northeast quarter (NEt) of Section Seven (7), Township One (1) North, Range Five (5) East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant from, on either side of, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 754+28.0, a point on the east line of Section 7, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, W.
