COUNTY DEED FOR ACCESS ROAD EASEMENT

SKAMANIA COUNTY, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the statutes of the State of Washington, in such cases made and provided, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way approximately 14 feet in width, with such additional widths as are necessary to provide for cuts, fills and turnouts and for curves at the angle points, all over and across the lands of the undersigned in

All that portion of the southwest half  $(SW_2)$  of the D. Baughman Donation Land Claim Number forty-two (42) in Section two (2), Township two (2) North, Range seven (7) East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, lying northerly of State Highway No. 8 as said highway was established and so designated on the 30th day of August, 1924,

for the following purposes, namely: the right to enter and to clear of timber, endangering trees, and brush; to grade, level, cut, fill, drain, build, maintain, repair, and rebuild a road or highway and such culverts, bridges, turnouts, retaining walls, or otheraappurtenant structures as may be necessary, on, over and across the land embraced within the right-of-way, the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the survey line of the Bonneville Power Administration, Bonneville-Coulee transmission line at survey station 225+57.65, said point being
