Contract No. 10216 Washington Division Five-year contract

Northern Pacific Railway Company.

Contract made this twenty-second day of June A. D. 1937, between Northern Pacific Railway Company, a corporation of the State of Wisconsin, vendor and David Hodes of Portland in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, purchaser.

The vendor, in consideration of the sum of six hundred seventy-five and 24/100 (\$675.24) Dollars to be paid as hereinafter agreed; and of the faithful performance of the covenants, agreements and conditions hereinafter expressed on the part of the purchaser, agrees to sell to the purchaser the parcels of land situate in the County of Skamania and State of Washington described as follows, to-wit:

Lots one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4) and east half of west half $(E_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of Section seven (7) in township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing three hundred thirty-seven and sixty-two hundredths (337.62) acres, more or less, according to the United States Government Survey;
