SPENCER, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to said CRAIG L. SPENCER and his heirs and assigns forever the following property situated in the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, to-wit:

All the timber now located on the following described real property, to-wit: The Southeast Quarter of Section 33 in Township 3 North, and the West Half of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and Lot 4 of Section 3 in Township 2 North of Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Said grantee may enter upon the above described real property and cut and remove therefrom all timber now located thereon, and may construct and maintain camps and other operating appliances on said real property and may remove the same from said real property at any time, and may construct and use such roads and passageways as he may desire for any purpose whatsoever -- subject only to the Governmental reservations in recorded patents to said land and easements heretofore given for a "C.C.C." roadway and to H. A. Dent.

All timber sold and conveyed to said grantee by this Deed shall be removed from said real property within ten years from date hereof; and at the end of said ten years, or upon the sooner surrender of said real property to said grantor, all standing and fallen timber and structures then on said real property shall be deemed to have been abandoned by said grantee and shall belong to and be the property of said grantor, its successors and assigns.

All taxes against said real property payable in the year 1941 and thereafter until the surrender of said real property by said grantor shall be paid by said grantee.

Said grantor does hereby covenant to and with said grantee that said grantor is the own er of the timber above described and that said timber is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, and that said grantor will warrant and defend the title thereto against the claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
