of-way be and the compensation shall be ascertained and awarded in this proceeding and established by judgment herein pursuant to law.

3. That the land referred to in this decree, in, to and upon which the United States is given the perpetual easement and right-of-way hereinbefore described, is situated in Skamania County and Clark County, Washington, and is bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Tract BCV-12 That portion of Lot 5 of Section 25, lying west of the Spokane-Portland & Seattle Railway Company's railroad right of way, and that portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 lying easterly of the center line of the old North Bank Highway as said highway was located and used on June 2, 1927, all in township 2 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant from, on either side of, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across, upon, and/or adjacent to the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 195+75.6, a point on the west line of the Elizabeth Snooks D.L.C. No. 37 in Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 6 East, of the Willamette Meridian, said point being S. 1° 13' E. a distance of 1213.8 feet from a wooden stake marking the northeast corner of Lot 8 of said Section 25; thence S. 70° 09' W. a distance of 1036.4 feet to survey station 206+12.0, a point on the west line of said Section 25, said point being S. 1° 25' N. a distance of 1549 feet from the quarter section corner on the west line of said Section 25; thence continuing S. 70° 09' W. a distance of 15.9 feet to survey station 206+27.9 back equals 204+00.0 ahead; thence S 66° 25' W. a distance of 2666.5 feet to survey station 230+66.5, a point on the south line of Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, said point being S. 89° 35' E. a distance of 123.7 feet from the quarter section corner on the south line of said Section 26.

The above-described parcel of land has a length of 1713 feet and contains 3.9 acres, more or less.

Tract BCV-111 That portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, W. M., Clark County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant from, on either side of, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 436+17.0, a point on the east line of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, W. M., said point being N. 0° 26' E. a distance of 333.8 feet from the quarter section corner on the east line of said Section 35; thence N. 57° 34' W. a distance of 3239.2 feet to survey station 468+56.2; thence N. 56° 42' W. a distance of 1019.8 feet to survey station 478+76.0, a point on the north line of said Section 35, said point being S. 89° 59' E. a distance of 1708.4 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 35.

The above-described strip of land has a length of 1288 feet and contains 3.0 acres more or less.

Tract BCV-112 That portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, W. M., Clark County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant from, on either side of, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 436+17.0, a point on the east line of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 3 East, W. M., said point being N. 0° 26' E. a distance of 333.8 feet from the quarter section corner on the east line of said Section 35; thence N. 57° 34' W. a distance of 3239.2 feet to survey station 468+56.2; thence N. 56° 42' W. a distance of 1019.8 feet to survey station 478+76.0, a point on the north line of said section 35, said point being S. 89° 59' E. a distance of 1708.4 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 35.

The above-described strip of land has a length of 1139 feet and contains 2.6 acres more or less.

Tract BCV-113 That portion of Lots 4 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 3 of section 26, said Lot 3 being that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 lying south of the south line of the B. L. Gardner D.L.C. No. 43, all in Township 2 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, Clark County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 100 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 50 feet distant from, on either side of, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas Vancouver transmission line as located and staked on the ground, over, across upon, and/or adjacent to the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:
