

Beginning at survey station 478+76.0, a point on the south line of Section 26, Township 2 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, said point being S. 89° 59' E. a distance of 1708.4 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 26; thence N. 56° 42' W. a distance of 2033.2 feet to survey station 499+09.2, a point on the west line of said Section 26; said point being N. 0° 35' E. along said west line a distance of 331.5 feet from the southwest corner of the B. L. Gardner D.L.C. No. 43 in township 2 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian.

The above-described strip of land has a length of 1417 feet and contains 3.3 acres more or less.

Tract BCV-202 That portion of that part of the Wm. P. French D.L.C. No. 56 lying southeasterly of the right of way of the Northern Pacific Railway Company in Sections 11 and 12, and that portion of the John C. Dodd D.L.C. No. 60 in Section 12, described as beginning at a point which is S. 89° 50' W. a distance of 1595.3 feet from the northwest corner of the E. Thomlinson D.L.C. No. 42 in Township 2 North, Range 1 East W. M.; thence S. 89° 50' W. 74.7 feet, more or less, to the west line of said John C. Dodd D. L. C.; thence north along said west line 573.5 feet; thence N. 89° 50' E. 63.8 feet to the center of the County Road; thence S. 1° 44' E. to the point of beginning, all in township 2 North, Range 1 East, W. M., Clark County, Washington; which lies within a strip of land 300 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 25 feet distant southerly from, and 275 feet distant northerly from, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 599+00.1, a point on the east line of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 1 East, W. M., said point being S. 0° 06' W. a distance of 974.2 feet from the quarter section corner on the east line of said Section 12; thence S. 85° 34' W. a distance of 364.4 feet to survey station 602+64.5; thence S. 79° 04' W. a distance of 5020.4 feet to survey station 652+84.9, a point on the west line of said section 12, said point being N. 1° 03' E. a distance of 727.3 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 12; thence continuing S. 79° 04' W. a distance of 1539.7 feet to survey station 668+24.6, a point on the west line of the Wm. P. French D.L.C. No. 56 in Township 2 North, Range 1 East, W.M., said point being S. 0° 57' W. a distance of 1199.2 feet from the northwest corner of said Wm. P. French D.L.C.

The above-described strip of land has a length of 2740 feet and contains 18.2 acres more or less.

Tract BCV-202A That portion of the John C. Dodd D.L.C. No. 60 in Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 1 East, W. M., Clark County, Washington, described as beginning at a point on the west line of the John C. Dodd D.L.C., said point being S. 89° 50' W. 1670.0 feet, and thence north 573.5 feet from the northwest corner of the E. Thomlinson D. L. C. No. 42 in Township 2 North, Range 1 East, W. M; thence from said point of beginning N. 89° 50' E. 63.8 feet, more or less, to the center line of Market Road No. 6; thence northerly along the center line of said road a distance of 300 feet; thence west to the west line of said John C. Dodd D.L.C.; thence south along said west line to the point of beginning; which lies within a strip of land 300 feet in width, the boundaries of said strip lying 25 feet distant southerly from, and 275 feet distant northerly from, and parallel to the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line as now located and staked on the ground, over, across and upon the above property, said survey line being particularly described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 599+00.1, a point on the east line of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 1 East, W.M., said point being S. 0° 06' W. a distance of 974.8 feet from the quarter section corner on the east line of said Section 12; thence S. 85° 54' W. a distance of 364.4 feet to survey station 602+64.5; thence S. 79° 04' W. a distance of 5020.4 feet to survey station 652+84.9, a point on the west line of said Section 12, said point being N. 1° 03' E. a distance of 727.3 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 12.

The above-described parcel of land contains 0.2 acre more or less.

4. That possession of all such property that is now vacant, unoccupied and uncultivated be given to the United States to the extent of its rights under the perpetual easement and right-of-way hereinbefore described, January 19, 1942. That as to the part of such property that is now occupied or cultivated, possession be given to the United States to the extent of its perpetual easement and right-of-way as aforesaid, on the 1st day of February, 1942.
