Special Warranty Deed and Bill of Sale for Timber.

This special warranty deed made and entered into this the 1st day of August, 1942, by and between Henry Kline and Cora B. Kline, his wife, (whose names are also spelled "Cline"), F. A. Roby and Ida M. Roby, his wife, of Owensboro, Kentucky, parties of the first part, and A. J. Barbee, of Vancouver, Washington, party of the second part,

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of Ten and 00/100 (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable considerations, all cash in hand paid, the parties of the first part have this day sold and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, transfer and convey unto the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the merchantable timber located on the tract of land hereinafter described that may be cut and removed by the party of the second part from said land within a period of two (2) years from and including this date. Said land on which said timber is located is situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, and is particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section Eighteen (18) Township Three (3) North Range Ten (10) East of the Williamette Meridian and running thence West Three Hundred Twenty (320) rods to the township line between Ranges Nine (9) and ten (10) East of the Williamette Meridian. The said point being the Northwest corner of Lot Three (3) Section Eigteen (18) Township Three (3) North Range Ten (10) East of the Williamette Meridian; thence South on said township line Sixty-six and two-thirds (66 (273)) rods; thence East three Hundred Twenty (320) rods to the section line between Sections Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) in said township Three (3).
