Guardian's Deed.

This Indenture, made this 24th day of August, 1942, in the Town of Stevenson, County of Skamania and State of Washington, by and between Frieda Meiggs, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Guardian of the Estate of Vernon F. Meiggs, a minor, the party of the first part, and Frank Hunsaker, of White Salmon, Klickitat County, Washington, the party of the second part, Witnesseth:

Whereas, pursuant to notice given thereof, the said party of the first part did sell, subject to confirmation by the Superior Court of the State of Washington, in and for County of Skamania, the real estate hereinafter described, situated in said County, and at such sale the said party of the second part became the purchaser of the said real estate, for the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00), payable in cash; and

Whereas, the party of the first part made return of said sale on August 11, 1942, to the Clerk of the said Superior Court, and more than ten days thereafter, on to-wit the 24th day of August, 1942, the said Superior Court did make an order confirming the said sale and directing conveyance to be executed by the said party of the first part to the party of the second part.

Meiggs, a minor, as aforesaid, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00), the receipt thereof being hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said party of the second part all the right, title and interest of the Estate of the said Vernon F. Meiggs, a minor, in and to all of that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in said County of Skamania and State of Washington and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
