Beginning at the southeast corner of said Section; thence south 89° 23' 40" west along the south line of said Section 520.00 feet; thence north 18° 00' 50" west 444.51 feet; thence north 23° 31' 30" east 495.40 feet; thence south 15° 59' 45" east 489.67 feet; thence south 39° 01' 20" east 515.83 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; containing 5.80 acres, more or less.
