

A-16 Item: Commencing at a point on the section line between Sections Ten and Fifteen, Township Nine South, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian, Nine and Ninety-eight Hundredths feet East of a point due South of the Southeast corner of Block Six in the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, as shown by the recorded plat thereof, and running thence South about Fifty feet to the center of the slough; thence Westerly down said slough to a point due South of a point on the Section line between Sections Ten and Fifteen, Township Nine South, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian, Fifty-eight and Ninety-eight Hundredths feet due West of the place of beginning, and from thence running North to the South bank of the Stayton Water Ditch; thence North-easterly up the South bank of said water ditch to a point due North of the point of beginning; thence South to the point of beginning.

A-17—Sinks Canyon Hydroelectric Generating Plant

The hydroelectric generating plant known as the Sinks Canyon Plant, located in Fremont County, State of Wyoming, including the following described lands owned and used by the Company in connection therewith, namely:

A-17 Item 1: A strip of land bounded and described as follows: Commencing at a point which bears 1091.76 feet South from the north quarter corner of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 100 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian; thence South $34^{\circ} 35'$ West 1216.02 feet; thence South $24^{\circ} 01'$ West 248.74 feet; thence South $38^{\circ} 37'$ West 298.24 feet; thence West 120 feet; thence South 300 feet; thence East 600 feet; thence North 300 feet; thence $51^{\circ} 53'$ West 275.00 feet; thence North $24^{\circ} 01'$ East 251.26 feet; thence North $34^{\circ} 35'$ East 1070.98 feet; thence North 176.2 feet to point of beginning, containing 8.15 acres.

A-17 Item 2: All that part of the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Thirty-two North, Range One Hundred West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Fremont County, Wyoming, particularly described and bounded as follows: Commencing at a point which bears Nine Hundred and Forty-three and Fifty-seven Hundredths feet East of the North quarter corner of Section Seventeen aforesaid, running thence South Forty-eight degrees Fifty-one minutes West One Hundred Forty-six and Eleven Hundredths feet; thence South Forty-one degrees Nine minutes East Seventy and Sixty-seven Hundredths feet; thence South Fifty-four degrees Twenty-two minutes West Three Hundred Thirty and One-tenth feet, thence South Fifty degrees
