

C-120—Heppner Substation

In Morrow County, State of Oregon:

C-120 Item: The site for this substation is described in subdivision J-6 Item 1 of Article XXI of that certain Mortgage and Deed of Trust, dated as of July 1, 1947, from Pacific Power & Light Company to Guaranty Trust Company of New York and Oliver R. Brooks, as Trustees.

C-121—Jordan Substation

In Morrow County, State of Oregon:

C-121 Item: A parcel of land in the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W. M., bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1270.8 feet south and 660.8 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 11, Township 1 South, Range 24 East, W. M.; thence north $73^{\circ}18'30''$ west 300 feet; thence at right angles south $16^{\circ}41'30''$ west 96.7 feet, more or less, to the north line of the Oregon State Highway right of way; thence southeasterly along said highway right of way to a point that bears south $16^{\circ}41'30''$ west from the point of beginning, thence north $16^{\circ}41'30''$ east 84.7 feet, more or less, to point of beginning.

C-122—New Albina Substation

In Multnomah County, State of Oregon:

C-122 Item: Beginning at the most northerly corner of Block 80 original townsite of Albina; thence southeasterly along the southwesterly line of North Loring Street, a distance of 490 feet, more or less, to its point of intersection with the center line of North Clark Avenue; thence southwesterly along the center line of North Clark Avenue a distance of 190 feet, more or less, to a point which is 10 feet northeasterly from the northeasterly line of North River Street; thence northwesterly along a line parallel to and 10 feet northeasterly from said northeasterly line of North River Street, a distance of 490 feet, more or less, to the northwesterly line of said Block 80; thence northeasterly along said northwesterly line of Block 80 a distance of 190 feet, more or less, to point of beginning.
