

degrees Ten minutes West Three and Seventeen-hundredths chains to a point of beginning, containing One and a Fraction acres, situated in Lane County, Oregon; together with the right to enter thereon over the land owned by Nathan Hill October 24, 1902, at any and all times for the purpose of erecting, repairing and maintaining a water reservoir of such dimensions and capacity as the officers of the Mountain States Power Company (now merged with Pacific Power & Light Company) may see fit; subject to the obligation of the Mountain States Power Company (now merged with Pacific Power & Light Company) to furnish Nathan Hill, his heirs or assigns, free of charge, at all practicable times, whenever there is water in the reservoir on said premises, and as long as said premises are used for reservoir purposes, all of the water needed or wanted for private use for said Nathan Hill, his heirs or assigns, upon the premises occupied by said Nathan Hill, near Springfield, Oregon, October 24, 1902, the water to be furnished by the one-inch galvanized iron pipe used by the said Nathan Hill, and no more water is to be used than can be taken through said one-inch pipe; subject also to the obligation of Mountain States Power Company (now merged with Pacific Power & Light Company) to furnish free of charge to The Booth-Kelly Lumber Company, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, water from any reservoir constructed on the above described premises through water pipes and systems of the said The Booth-Kelly Lumber Company for its use for drinking purposes, fire protection and in and about the mills and factories of said The Booth-Kelly Lumber Company or its successors near the Town of Springfield, Oregon, and for other purposes as are used in and about similar premises except that said water shall not be used for furnishing power or for transportation purposes.

G-5 Item 2: All that portion of Lot 1, of Section 1, in Township 18 South, Range 3 West of Willamette Meridian, lying south of a line described as follows: Beginning on the west line of said Lot 1, at a point 1184.85 feet south of the south line of Isaac Briggs Donation Land Claim No. 39, and running thence along the approximate center of the channel of the present slough, South $84^{\circ} 40' 36''$ East 133.05 feet; thence South $45^{\circ} 05'$ East 199.96 feet; thence South $49^{\circ} 02' 30''$ East 134.63 feet; thence North $60^{\circ} 17' 42''$ East 268.01 feet; thence North $42^{\circ} 07' 54''$ East 271.36 feet; thence North $59^{\circ} 53' 15''$ East 169.54 feet to the southwesterly line of a forty-foot roadway conveyed to Springfield Sand & Gravel Company by deed recorded in Book 203, at page 213, of the deed records of said Lane County; thence South $27^{\circ} 58'$ East, along said southwesterly line of said roadway, to the Willamette River; EXCEPT
