

the center line of the Mill City Manufacturing Co. Railroad, formerly the Hammond Lumber Co. Railroad; thence easterly along the south line of the right of way of said railroad approximately 1,125 feet to a point which is marked by a $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 20" bolt surrounded by rocks and which is S. $89^{\circ} 48'$ E. of the point of beginning; thence N. $89^{\circ} 48'$ W. 1,028.5 feet to the point of beginning.

J-26 Item 6: Beginning at a point 560 feet east and 50 feet north of the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on the south line of Sec. 29, T 9 S., R 3 E., W. M., thence North 650 feet; thence East 30 feet; thence South 650 feet; thence West 30 feet to the point of beginning. All corners mentioned in above description are marked by $\frac{5}{8}$ " bolts surrounded by rocks. It is understood that the above strip of land is to be used for road right of way only and that the same is to be left open to the public.

J-26 Item 7: A part of Lot 6 in Section 22, T. 9 S., R. 1 E., of the W. M., described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the North Half of said Section 22; thence East 100 rods to the Southerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad and the true place of beginning of the herein described tract; thence East, along the South line of the North Half of said Section, 26 rods; thence North 9 Rods to the Southerly right of way line of said Railroad; thence southwesterly along the Southerly line of said Railroad to the true place of beginning.

J-27—Lands in Marion County, State of Oregon:

J-27 Item 1: The East One-half of the following described tract of land, to wit: Commencing at a point Two Hundred Twelve links South from the Southeast corner of Block Six in the Town of Stayton in Marion County, Oregon, and running thence North Seventy-five degrees East Nine and Ninety-eight hundredths feet for a point of beginning; from said beginning point run South to the center line of the slough; thence up said Slough Easterly to a point due South of the Southwest corner of the Water Lot formerly owned by Cyrus and Alexander Clark, said Lot being described in deed recorded at page 42 of Book 18, Deed Records of Marion County, Oregon, thence North to the Section line between Sections Ten and Fifteen, in Township Nine South, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian and running thence still
