

*J-34 Item 2:* A strip of land One rod wide and One-half mile long along the West line of the Northwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Twenty-seven North, Range Twenty West of Montana Principal Meridian, containing One acre, more or less, and granted by the State of Montana to Big Fork Electric Power & Light Company under State Patent dated December 30, 1901, and filed for record January 4, 1902, in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Flathead County, Montana, in Book 57 of State Patents, at page 21.

*J-35—Lands in Lincoln County, State of Montana:*

*J-35 Item 1:* Lots Twelve, Thirteen and Fourteen in Block Fourteen of the Townsite of Libby (Original), now the City of Libby.

*J-35 Item 2:* Lot Six (6) in Block A of Johnston's Acres, according to the map of plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Lincoln County, Montana.

*J-36—Lands in Bonner County, State of Idaho:*

*J-36 Item 1:* All of that certain piece or parcel of land in the Village of Sandpoint, in the State of Idaho, beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot Eight, Block One, Weil's Addition to Sandpoint; thence North Fifty feet; thence East to the East line of said lot; thence in a Southeasterly direction to the Southeast corner of said lot; thence West One Hundred Fifty-five feet to the place of beginning.

*J-36 Item 2:* All of Block Twenty-two in the Original Townsite of Newport, Idaho, and that part of Lot Two, Section Twenty-four, Township Fifty-six North, Range Six West of the Boise Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of the most Northerly Lot in said Block Twenty-two; thence North Forty-five degrees East One Hundred Seventy-eight feet to the meander line along the South shore of Pend O'Reille River; thence along said meander line South Forty-five degrees East Five Hundred and Seven feet to the meander corner on Section line between Sections Twenty-four and Twenty-five, said Township and Range; thence West along said Section line Fifty-nine and Four-tenths feet to the quarter corner between said Sections Twenty-four and
