Access Road Easement

For and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-five Dollars (\$65.00) in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, a corporation; and Thomas M. Golden and Pearl Golden, contract purchasers, husband and wife now and at the time of entering into the contract, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the United States of America and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way approximately 14 feet in width, with such additional widths as are necessary to provide for cuts, fills and turnouts and for curves at the angle points, all over and across the lands of the undersigned in the

N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 North of Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, for the following purposes, namely: the right to enter and to clear of timber, endangering trees, and brush; to grade, level, cut, fill, drain, build, maintain, repair and rebuild a road or highway and such culverts, bridges, turnouts, retaining walls or other appurtenant structures as may be necessary, on, over and across the land embraced within the right-of-way, the center line of which is described as follows:
