of Deeds in Clatsop County, Oregon, subject, however, to the following:

(i) Reciprocal right-of-way agreement entered into between St. Helens Pulp and Paper Company, first party, and W. B. Hollenbeck, Fannie S. Hollenbeck, H. J. Carswell and Clara B. Carswell, second parties, as evidenced by instrument recorded in Book 175, page 763, Deed Records.

(4) A right of way for logging railroad as located and used by Big Creek Logging Company on August 27, 1943, said right of way to extend 16½ feet on each side of the center of Big Creek Logging Company's railroad as constructed on said date through Sections 7 and 18, said right of way containing 4 acres, more or less.
