to the center line of the County Road; thence Easterly along the center line of said County Road about 700 feet to the center of the intersection of said County Road with the private roadway known as the Takalo road; thence South along the center line of the said Takalo road to the point where said road intersects the center line of Section 30; thence West on said center line to the eighth post, the point of beginning; excepting therefrom the following:
