## Parcel 5:

A tract of land 25 feet in width, located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Columbia County, State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the center line of Columbia Street (now First Street) and the Southerly line of Cowlitz Street in the City of St. Helens, Oregon; thence South 16° 57′ East a distance of 670.0 feet; thence Southerly along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1,910.08 feet and to which the last described course is tangent, a distance of 1,270.0 feet through an angle of 38° 06′; thence South 21° 09′ West and tangent to the above described curve a distance of 3,317.7 feet; thence South 68° 51′ East a distance of 25 feet to the true point of beginning for this description; thence continuing South 68° 51′ East a distance of 25 feet; thence South 21° 09′ West a distance of 1,171.5 feet; thence North 68° 51′ West a distance of 25 feet; thence North 21° 09′ East a distance of 1,171.5 feet to the true point of beginning.

## PARCEL 6.

A tract of land, 25 feet in width, located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Columbia County, State of Oregon, beginning at a point which is the intersection of the center line of Columbia Street and the southerly line of Cowlitz Street in the City of St. Helens, Oregon; thence South 16° 57' East 670 feet; thence Southerly along the arc of a 1,910.08 foot radius curve to the right, and to which the last described course is tangent, a distance of 1,270.0 feet through an angle of 38° 06'; thence South 21° 09' West, tangent to said 1,910.08 foot radius curve, 2,617.7 feet; thence South 68° 51' East 25 feet to the true point of beginning for this description; thence continuing South 68° 51' East 25 feet; thence South 21° 09' West 700 feet; thence North 68° 51' West 25 feet; thence North 21° 09' East 700 feet to the true point of beginning.

The above described tract of land is parallel to and 25 feet south-easterly from the center line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's St. Helens branch line, and contains 17,500 square feet or 0.40 acre more or less.
