

Section 8 which point is 531.25 feet East of the West line thereof; thence East along said South line of the Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter a distance of 402.5 feet to a point; thence North approximately 884.0 feet to the present County Road right of way; thence following said County Road right of way in a Northeasterly and Northerly direction to the Section line between Sections 5 and 8 approximately 1190 feet to the point of beginning.

(2) Beginning at a point on the Section line between Sections 7 and 8 which is 500.0 feet South of the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8; thence East 531.25 feet to a point; thence South to the South line of the Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter; thence West along said South line of said Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter 531.25 feet to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter; thence North along the Section line between Sections 7 and 8 to the point of beginning, containing 10.24 acres, more or less.

(1) Lot 10 of Section 29, *excepting therefrom* a triangular shaped tract of land containing  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Lot 10; thence East on the lot line 134 feet; thence North  $23^{\circ}$  West approximately 313 feet to the intersection with the West line of said Lot 10; thence South to the point of beginning, and *subject to*:

(i) Reservation of coal and iron as contained in deed recorded in Volume 5, page 10, Deed Records.
