This deed is also made with the understanding and agreement that said grantee, his heirs, executors, and assigns, shall not use the said premises for other than residential purposes and will not at any time use the said property for commercial purposes, and said grantee, his heirs, executors and assigns, shall not maintain or keep any livestock, poultry or rabbits upon the said premises.

This deed is also made with the understanding that the grantee, his heirs, executors and assigns shall have free access for swimming purposes to the large pool in said Washougal River, located near the East boundary line of the tract now owned by the grantor situated in the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 34. To Have and To Hold, the above described and granted premises unto the said Howard W. Dummert his heirs and assigns forever.

And Eva King the grantor above named does covenant to and with the above named grantee his heirs and assigns that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, except such lien and encumbrances as grantee may have permitted or created since July 31, 1940, the date of a contract pertaining to said premises between the parties hereto, and except 1940 and subsequent taxes and that she will and her heirs, executors and administrators, shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises, and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except as to the above-mentioned encumbrances liens and taxes.
