ORDER APPROVING FINAL ACCOUNT

The executrix's final report and petition for distribution came on regularly for hearing on this date, and all matters and things being understood and considered by the court, the court finds:

I.

That Ludwig Brunhuber died testate at Ken Ridge, Skamania County, Washington, January 14th, 1942, being at the time of his death a resident of Clark County, Washington, and leaving property therein subject to administration herein.

II.

That said decedent left a will which was on the 28th day of January 1942, admitted to probate in this court and petitioner appointed executrix thereof.

III.

That this executrix caused notice to creditors to be published herein, the first publication thereof being on the 10th day of February 1942, and that more than six months have expired since said date, and that no claims have been presented or filed in this estate which are now unpaid.

IV.

That after giving due notice to the inheritance tax department of the State of Washington, this executrix made inventory and has returned herein an appraisal of the property belonging to this estate, the total appraisement thereof being \$117,722.77.
