ACCESS ROAD EASEMENT

For and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, JACOB FRANZ, a bachelor now and at the time of acquiring title, have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way approximately 14 feet in width, with such additional widths as are necessary to provide for cuts, fills, and turnouts and for curves at the angle point, all over and across the lands of the undersigned in

Lot 6 of Section 5, Township 1 North of Range 6 East, Willamette Meridian, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington,

for the following purposes, namely: the right to enter and to clear of timber, endangering trees, and brush; to grade, level, cut, fill, drain, build, maintain, repair, and rebuild a road or highway and such culverts, bridges, turnouts, retaining walls, or other appurtenant structures as may be necessary, on, over, and across the land embraced within the right-of-way, the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning at survey station 410+53.88, a point on the survey line of the Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 2 North, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, said point being 246.11 feet north and 1378.51 feet east of the southwest corner of said Section 32; thence S. 31° 10' W. 78.2 feet; thence S. 16° 07' E. 169.9 feet; thence S. 0° 25' W. 105.3 feet; thence N. 54° 35' W. 103.9 feet; thence N. 44° 06' W. 138.1 feet; thence N. 61° 17' W. 75.3 feet; thence N. 81° 18' W. 109.9 feet to survey station 414+25.38, a point on the survey line of said Bonneville-Camas-Vancouver transmission line in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 32, said point being 122.93 feet north and 1028.96 feet east of the southwest corner of said Section 32.

It is understood and agreed that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its agents or assigns, shall have the right to appropriate from any lands of the undersigned, such timber and rock as may be necessary for the construction and repair of said road,

The undersigned will be permitted the right of ingress and egress over and across said road, and the right to pass and repass along and on said road insofar as the same extends across the lands of the undersigned, said right to be exercised in a manner that will not interfere
