Anna P. Reynolds to Fred Buntje

Bill of Sale

Know All Men By These Presents, That Anna P. Reynolds, surviving widow of Charles H. Reynolds, deceased, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to her in hand paid by Fred Buntje, a single person, party of the second part, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part that certain spring located approximately 60 feet South and 40 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 5 Township 1 North, Range 6 East W.M., together with the right to take the water therefrom by pipe line, flume or other conduit on, over and across the land of Jacob Franz, the original grantor of this water right, and who still owns said lands, to the property of the said party of the second part. Also the right to go upon said land for the purpose of cleaning and caring for said spring, and to repair and maintain any pipe line, flume or other conduit, and to construct, maintain and repair any reservoir at said spring for the purpose of collecting the water thereof. Also the right to place and maintain a fence around the said spring, but not at a greater distance therefrom than 30 feet. Said spring being situated in Skamania County, Washington.

This conveyance also to include pipe lines and material betterments laid, placed or erected in and about said spring since August 7th, 1924, the date Charles H. Reynolds

and Anna P. Reynolds, his wife acquired the same.

To Have And To Hold The Same unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part that she is the owner of said water right and has good right to convey the same.
