This Indenture, made this 25th day of August, 1955,

between Amos D. Reid Sheriff in and for the County of Skamania State of Washington, party of the first part, and of party of the second part, witnesseth that

REID, the Sheriff in and for the County of Skamania and State of Washington, said party of the first part, by virtue of the said Chattel Mortgage, notice, the statute in such cases made and provided, and said sale, to-wit: as aforesaid, and for and in consideration of the said sum of \$2,958.00 Dollars, to him in hand paid as aforesaid, by the said second party, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, all the right, title and interest of said Gilbert Cook, mortgagor as aforesaid, in and to said mortgaged property
