And said second party agrees to pay as consideration for the use of said water and the right to lay the pipe line for the conveyance of said water, the consideration of \$1.00 which is hereby acknowledged by said first party. It is understood and agreed that should said second party for any reason find it necessary to absent himself from said premises for a period of a week or more at a time during the dry season, he shall shut said water off during his absence and should he fail so to do, the first party may do so at his option and during the absence of second party only.
