Modification of Lease Description.

This agreement, dated 30th day of December, 1941, by and between Maurice D. Stauffer and Ruth Stauffer, his wife, hereinafter referred to as "Lessors", and Shell Oil Company, incorporated, a corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Shell"

Witnesseth: That, whereas, under date of 11th day of September, 1939, Raymond Meiggs and Frieda Meiggs, his wife, as Lessors, leased to Shell Oil Company, incorporated that certain piece or parcel of real property situate in the City of Underwood, County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly described as follows:

Lot One (1), Block One (1), Underwood Townsite, together with all buildings, improvements and equipment located on the said premises and more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached to said lease.

Memorandum of which said Lease was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of said Skamania County on the 31st day of October, 1939, in Book 3, at page 398, agreement and leases records, Underwood, Washington; and

Whereas, Lessors above named, by purchase of the demised premises have, effective Oct. 15, 1941 succeeded to the interest of the above mentioned Lessors under said Lease and are now the owners of the premises covered thereby; and

Whereas, the parties hereto desire to modify said Lease in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the Lessors in hand paid by Shell, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable considerations to Lessors moving, Lessors and Shell hereby agree said Lease shall be and the same is hereby modified and amended by striking and deleting therefrom the property description above set forth and substituting in its place and stead the following description, which for all purposes shall be deemed to be and shall be the parcel of land covered by the aforesaid Lease:

Book 3 of Agreement and Lease

A portion of Lot 1, Block 1, Underwood Townshite described as follows: Commencing at a point formed by the intersection of the easterly line of Underwood Road and the northerly line of the State Highway; thence northerly along the easterly line of Underwood Road a distance of 42' 6" to a point; thence at right angles easterly 17 feet to a point; thence at right angles southerly and parallel with the easterly line of Underwood Road 31' 3" to a point; thence at right angles easterly 35' 6" to a point on the easterly boundary line of Lot 1; thence southerly along the easterly boundary line of Lot 1, 32' 6" to a point on the northerly line of the state highway; thence westerly along the northerly line of the state highway 54' to the point of beginning. Together with that portion of the building and improvements located on the demised premises used for the storage and sale of petroleum and accessory supplies for automobiles and specifically the following equipment:
