LEASE

This lease, made and executed between Hattie L. Brown, widow of North Bonneville, Washington, of the first part, and Mr. J. A. Frye, of North Bonneville, Washington, of the second part.

WITNESSETM: Lat in consideration of 'be rents and other sevenants hereinafter expressed, the first party demises and lease and does hereby demise and lease to the second party the following described property.

The building known as the former Goddard Pool Hall situated on the main street of North Bonneville, approximately on the south center of the Brown Twact, a part of the old Chenowith donation land claim, beginning at a point in the North line of State Road number eight, (#8), three hundred and twenty (520°) feet West of Section line between sections numbered twenty-one (21) and numbered twenty-two (22), township two (2) North Range seven '7) East W. M. in Skemania County, Washington.
