the TOWN OF NORTH BONNEVILLE in the State of Washington (hereinafter referred to as "the cown") and PAULINE C. PETERSON, as executrix of the estate of P. A. Peterson, deceased (hereinafter referred to as "Peterson"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the town desires to buy and Peterson has agreed to sell to the town certain quanities of water on the terms and conditions hereinafter provided,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

- L. Commencing on the 12 day of May, 1948 and extending to October 31, 1948 E.m. RAO FCP Peterson agrees to deliver to the town at the existing connection (as the same is hereinafter located) not to exceed 200,000 cubic feet of water per month. The existing connection is located approximately 100 feet east of the southwest corner of the P. A. Peterson tract, which tract is situated in "kamenia County, Washington immediately adjacent to the city limits of said town on the east. All water shall be delivered by gravity flow and in the condition which is flows from the source of supply.
 - 2. The rates which the town shall pay Peterson are as follows:
 - (a) Water furnished to June 30, 1948 not in excess of 200,000 cubic feet the

(b) Water furnished after June 30, 1948 - \$100.00 per month for quanities not in excess of 200,000 cubic feet in any month. (c) Quanities over 200,000 cubic feet in any month - \$.03 per 100 cubic feet. Peterson shall not be obligated to supply more than 200,000 cubic feet per month but may supply additional quanities if requested by the town and such quanities are available.

3. Peterson shall not be liable in any manner for failure to deliver water when such failu ; is the direct or indirect result of fire or other casualty, Acts of God, or circumstances or happendings beyond or outside her control.

Peterson shall not be liable for failure to supply water during periods when it is necessary to stop the flow of water for repairs.

4. The town shall have the right to cancel this agreement at any time upon written notice to Peterson, provided that all amounts on Peterson at the time of cancellation shall be paid promptly.
