Albert Rumpff et ux to Jack Woodruff et al

OIL AND GAS LEASE

AGREEMENT, Made and entered into 20th day of April, 1949, by and between Albert Rumpff and Aili Rumpff, husband and wife, of Skamania, Wash. party of the first part, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more) and Jack Woodruff, Roy Woodruff and Robert Woodruff, party of the second part, lessee.

WITNESSETH, That the said lessor, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) DOLLARS cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents does grant, demise, lease and let unto the said lessee, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and laying pipe lines, and building tank, powers, stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the County of Skamania State of Washington described as follows to-wit:

That portion of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26 Township 2 North Range 6 East WM as follows: Commence at a point 700 feet South and 360 feet west of the Quarter corner on the East line of said Section which point is on the West line of State Highway No. 8 where there is a post of fir 3 inches in diameter marked "S" bearing from a fir tree 8 inches in diameter 22 feet Northeast from said post in Southerly direction along the Westerly line of said Highway No. 8 50 feet; thence North 74° West 300 feet; thence North 16° East 50 feet; thence North 74° West 257 feet; thence North 16° East 350 feet more or less to the Southern boundary of the Kuffler Road; thence in an Easterly direction along the said line to intersection with the West line of State Highway No. 8; thence in a Southerly direction to the beginning. Containing 5 acres.

and containing 5 acres, more or less.

It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of Ten years from this date, and as long thereafter as oil or gas, or either of them, is produced from said land by the lessee.

In consideration of the premises the said lessee covenants and agrees:

1st. To deliver to the credit of lessor, free of cost, in the pipe line to which he may connect his wells, the equal one-eighth part of all oil produced and saved from said leased premises.

2nd. To pay the lessor 1/8 royalty of oil or gas DOLLARS each year in advance, for the gas from each well where gas only is found, while the same is being used off the premises, and lessor to have gas free of cost from any such well for all stoves and all inside lights in the principal dwelling houses on said land during the same time by making his own connections with the wells at his own risk and expense.

3rd. To pay lessor for gas produced from any oil well and used off the premises or for the manufacture of casinghead gas 1/8 of oil or gas produced, for the time during which such gas shall be used, said payments to be made each three months in advance.

If no well be commenced on said land on or before the first day of May, 1950, this lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee on or before that date shall pay or tender to the lessor, or to the lessor's credit in the Bank of Stevenson Bank at Stevenson, Wash. or its successors, which shall continue as the depository regardless of changes in the ownership of said land, the sum of 25 cts per acre, which shall operate as a rental and cover the privilege of deferring the commencement of a well for Twelve months from said date. In like manner and upon like payments or tenders the commencement of a well may be further deferred for like periods of the same number of months successively. And it is understood and agreed that the consideration first recited herein, the down payment, covers not only the privileges granted to the date when said first rental is payable as aforesaid, but also the lessee's option of extending that period as aforesaid, and any and all other rights conferred.

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Should the first well drilled on the above described land be a dry hole, then and in that event, if a second well is not commenced on said land within twelve months from the expiration of the last rental period which rental has been paid, this lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee on or before the expiration of said twelve months shall resume payment of rentals in the same amount and in the same manner as hereinbefore provided. And it is agreed that upon the resumption of the payment of rentals, as above provided, that the last preceding paragraph hereof, governing the payments of rentals and the effect thereof, shall continue in force just as though there had been no interruption in the rental payments.

If said lessor owns a less interest in the above described land than the entire and undivided fee simple estate therein, then the royalties and rentals herein provided shall be paid the lessor only in the proportion which his interest bears to the whole and undivided fee.

Lessee shall have the right to use, free of cost, gas, oil, and water produced on said land for its operations thereon, except water from wells of lessor.

When requested by lessor, lessee shall bury his pipe lines below plow depth.

No well shall be drilled nearer than 200 feet to the house or barn now on said premises, without the written consent of the lessor.

Lessee shall pay for damages caused by his operations to growing crops on said land.

Lessee shall have the right at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing.

If the estate of either party hereto is assigned, and the privilege of assigning in whole or in part is expressly allowed, the covenants hereof shall extend to their heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns, but no change in the ownership of the land or assignment of rentals or royalties shall be binding on the lessee until after the lessee has been furnished with a written transfer or assignment or a true copy thereof; and it is hereby agreed in the event this lease shall be assigned as to a part or as to parts of the above described lands and the assignee or assignees of such part or parts shall fail or make default in the payment of the proportionate part of the rents due from him or them, such default shall not operate to defeat or affect this lease in so far as it covers a part or parts of said lands upon which the said lessee or any assignee thereof shall make due payment of said rental.

Lessor hereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to the lands herein described, and agrees that the lessee shall have the right at any time to redeem for lessor, by payment, ^{and mortgages,} taxes or other liens on the above described lands, in the event of default of payment by lessor, and be subrogated to the rights of the holder thereof.

John Franz to Jack Woodruff et al

AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 29th day of April, 1949, by and between John Franz, widower, of _____, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more), and Jack Woodruff, Roy Woodruff and Robert Woodruff, hereinafter called lessee:

WITNESSETH: That the said lessor, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollars, cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents does grant, demise lease and let unto the said lessee for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas and of laying pipe lines, and of building tanks, power stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, described as follows, to-wit:

The West One-half of the Southeast Quarter, the South One-half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, and the North One-half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, All in Section 32 Township 2 North Range 6 EWM. Also the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7 and also all shorelands fronting this acreage, in Section 5 Township 1 North Range 6 East WM.

of Section 32 & 1, Township 2 N & 1, Range 6 EWM, and containing 352.1 acres, more or less. It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of Ten years from this date, and as long thereafter as oil or gas or either of them is produced from said land by lessee.

In consideration of the premises the said lessee covenants and agrees:

1st. To deliver to the credit of lessor, free of cost, in the pipe line to which lessee may connect wells on said land, the equal one-eighth part of all oil produced and saved from the leased premises.

2nd. To pay lessor one-eighth ($1/8$) of the gross proceeds each year, payable quarterly, for the gas from each well where gas only is found, while the same is being used off the premises, and if used in the manufacture of gasoline a royalty of one-eighth ($1/8$), payable monthly at the prevailing market rate for gas; and lessor to have gas free of cost from any such well for all stoves and all inside lights in the principal dwelling on said land during the same time, by making lessor's own connections with the well at lessor's own risk and expense.

3rd. To pay lessor for gas produced from any oil well and used off the premises or in the manufacture of gasoline or any other product a royalty of one-eighth ($1/8$) of the proceeds, at the mouth of the well, payable monthly at the prevailing market rate.

If no well be commenced on said land or within the boundaries of the lands described as follows: on or before the First day of May 1950, this lease shall terminate as to both parties, unless the lessee shall on or before that date pay or tender to the lessor or to the lessor's credit in the Bank of Stevenson, Bank at Stevenson, Washington, or its successors, which shall continue as the depository regardless of changes in the ownership of said land, the sum of Twenty-Five Cents (\$0.25) per acre dollars, which shall operate as a rental and cover the privilege of deferring the commencement of a well for Twelve months from said date. In like manner and upon like payments or tenders, the commence-
