This lease terminates if seining is proribited by law.

Said lessee shall not damage said property beyond usel wear and tear and shall not assign this lease nor any rights thereunder without the written consent of lessors thereto in writing.

And should default be made in the payment of the rent when due and for . Q days thereafter, the said lessors, their agent or attorney may re-enter the premises and take possession, and at his option terminate this lease, and the said lesses shall not contest the same.
