Martin, party of the second part, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents bargain, sell and deliver unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, all of the following described personal property, to-wit:

170,174---Feet of fir logs in Drano Lake near Cook, Washington as per scale sheets of Columbia River Log scaling & Grading Bureau herewith attached No. 2589, and No. 2588, dated August 10, 1928 and being No. 9 and NO. 10 of Carney Logging Co.,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever.

And the first party hereby covenants with the said party of the second part that the Carney Logging Co. is the lawful owners of said logs and chattels; that they are free from all encumbrances; that the Carney Logging Co. has good right to sell the same as aforesaid, and that they will and their successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the title thereto unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
