TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever.

And the first party hereby covenants with the said party of the second part that the Carney Logging Co. is the lawful owner of said logs and chattels; that they are free from all encumbrances; that the Carney Logging Co. has good right to sell the same as aforesaid, and that they will and their successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the title thereto unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomever.
