Logging Equipment: One 9½ x 10 Tacoma Donkey, engine No 1175; 4 trip blocks 1 Tommy Moore block; 4 chokers.

Mill and equipment: One 12½ X 15 Russel Engine complete; ~~One~~ 108 X 44 boiler complete; 1 carriage with 3 head blocks; 1 top and bottom husk frame complete; Two 48" saws; Two cut off saws; 1 edger; shafting, belting and pump complete; 1 power pump.

Shop: One anvil; One vice and forge. Also all other personal property mentioned in that certain chattel mortgage dated April 14th, 1925, made and executed by J.R.Kee, E.J. Kline, J.A. Davis, Carl E. Davis and R.E. Davis as mortgagors, to L.S.Franck, mortgagee, (the same now being at or near Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington.) except therefrom articles specifically enumerated therein and omitted herein.
