This Instrument, made the 30th day of June, 1944, between O. P. Lewellen and Alice J. Lewellen, his wife, hereinafter called the "Grantors," and Washington Veneer Company, a corporation, hereinafter called the "Grantee," Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), and good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Grantors have sold and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Grantee, its successors and assigns, the following described timber, to-wit:

Parcel 1 - All timber standing, lying or being on the Northeast Quarter (NE¹/₄), Section Sixteen (16), Township Seven (7) North, Range Five (5) East of W. M., containing 160.00 acres, more or less, in Skamania County, Washington.

Parcel 2 - All old growth fir and cedar timber only, on Lots Three (3) and Nine (9), and the Northwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NWt SWt) of Section Twentysix (26), Township Seven (7) North, Range Give (5) East of W. M., containing 103.35 acres, more or less, in Skamania County, Washington.

Parcel 3 - All timber standing, lying or being on the North Half of North Half ($N_{\overline{z}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$) of Northwest Quarter (NWt) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Seven (7) North, Range Five (5) East of W. M., containing 40.00 acres, more or less, in Skamania County, Washington.

The time for the removal of the timber on said Parcel 1 was extended by order of the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of Washington dated December 4, 1943.

It is understood that all of the above described timber was acquired by the Grantors from the State of Washington by the following Bills of Sale, to-wit:
