- 4. This deed is given in lieu of a similar deed bearing the same date made by the grantor herein to the grantees herein, and which said deed is reported to have been lost or destroyed without having been placed of record.
- 5. A mortgage for \$500.00 dated February 3, 1928, executed by the grantees herein to the grantor herein, and recorded July 16, 1937 in Book U of Mortgages at page 83 (File No. 24408) records of Skamania County, Washington.
