WHEREAS in addition to the property described in the Mortgage, as heretofore supplemented, the Company has acquired certain other property, rights and interests in property; and

WHEREAS the Company has heretofore issued, in accordance with the provisions of the Mortgage, as supplemented, bonds of a series entitled and designated First Mortgage Bonds, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ % Series due 1977 (hereinafter called the bonds of the First Series), in the aggregate principal amount of Thirty-eight Million Dollars (\$38,000,000), of which Twenty-nine Million Dollars (\$29,000,000) in aggregate principal amount are now Outstanding; bonds of a series entitled and designated First Mortgage Bonds, 3% Series due 1980 (hereinafter called the bonds of the Second Series), in the aggregate principal amount of Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000), all of which are now Outstanding; bonds of a series entitled and designated First Mortgage Bonds, 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ % Series due 1982 (hereinafter called the bonds of the Third Series), in the aggregate principal amount of Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$12,500,000), all of which are now Outstanding; bonds of a series entitled and designated First Mortgage Bonds, 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ % Series due September 1, 1982 (hereinafter called the bonds of the Fourth Series), in the aggregate principal amount of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000), all of which are now
